General Questions

When & where does the Expo take place?

The Expo takes place on May 7 & 8 at the Walter E. Washington Convention Center in downtown Washington D.C.

What are the hours of the event?

Doors open to the public at 7:00am for the Ash Carter Exchange. The Expo Floor opens at 8:00am. The doors close at 6:00pm, and the last admission to the event is at 5:30pm.

Getting here by public transit?

The Convention Center sits atop the Mt. Vernon Square/7th Street-Convention Center station served by Metro's Green and Yellow lines. Alternatively, take the Red Line to the Gallery Place-Chinatown Metro station which is a 5 minute walk from the Convention Center. Visit WMATA.com or call (202) 637-7000 for maps, schedules and more information on traveling by metro or bus.

Getting here by car & parking?

Whether you're driving yourself or using a rideshare service, Google Maps can help get you here. Multiple parking garages are located around the Convention Center with hourly and daily rates.

I'm registered and attending. What next?

Upon arrival, you will go through a security screening and then pick up your badge at the Registration area. We recommend building your own personal agenda on the app for ease of navigating the event.

Can I bring a backpack/purse?

Yes. All bags will be checked by security.

Will there be security present?

Yes, there will be security present.

Are there any off-limit items at the Convention Center?

Yes! Prohibited items include: aerosols, ammunition, balloons, bicycles, coolers, drones and other unmanned aircraft systems, explosives, firearms, flammable liquids, glass, thermal, or metal containers, public address systems, laser pointers, recreational motorized mobility devices, large signs and placards, toy guns, weapons of any kind, and any other items determined to be potential safety hazards.

Are pets allowed?

Only service animals are permitted at the Convention Center.

Can I bring food and water to the event?

No outside food or beverages are allowed inside the Convention Center. There will be food and beverages available for purchase inside the Convention Center.

Is there a lost & found?

Yes, there is a lost and found designated area and an information area.

Will there be medical emergency services available?

Yes.

Can I leave & come back?

Yes!
